Entry Fees

Owners are responsible for entering the proper class and height and paying the correct fees. Complete class rules can be found on the AKC website www.akc.org.

Class fees are: \$20 1st run, \$15 2nd run, \$15 3rd run. Includes AKC recording fees of \$3/dog/run/day.

Checks should be made payable to RBTF. Entry is not valid if underpaid.

What does "WALK-WALK-RUN-RUN" mean?

Handlers of all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of a class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Walkthroughs may be split to avoid overcrowding in the ring, and such splits will be announced during the class briefing. Depending on what most expedites trial operation, split walkthroughs may be in a WALK-RUN-WALK-RUN format, in which the first half of the class walks the course and then runs, and then the second half of the class walks and then runs. Or, split walkthroughs may be in a WALK-WALK-RUN-RUN format, in which the first half walks and then the second half walks, and then the first half runs, and the second half runs.

Move-ups and other changes

In advance of the trial weekend, dogs may be moved up to a higher level at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing or email by the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on the Monday preceding the event.

Sunday move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday. Note that move-ups from Novice A to Novice B are not allowed after the close of entries. Note that except for the above defined allowable move-ups, no other changes may be made to an entry after closing date except for correction of errors made by the Trial Secretary during data entry.

Entries will be processed on a first received basis. Limit 660 runs per day. No hand delivery of entries within the first 24 hours of opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope. Entries may not be accepted or cancelled after the closing date. All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only. Minimum charge of \$25 for all returned checks.

Permission has been granted by the American Kennel Club for the holding of this event under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Mr. James P. Crowley, Secretary.

Jump Height Card

If you do not have a height card, permanent or temporary, this event is fortunate enough to have an official measuring official present who can measure you for your permanent height card. In this case you **MUST** be measured before you run, regardless of what height you jump.

If you have a temporary height card and are still under two years of age, you do not need to be measured. Over two: you **MUST** measure.

If you have two temporary height cards and are waiting for your permanent card to be mailed to you, you do not need to be measured.

Closing Date Clarification

Closing date for this event is May 24 at 6pm. Your physical entry and fee must be in the Trial Secretary's hands by this date and time in order for your entry to be valid. If you need your entry to get to its destination by overnight, then **DO** use the post office overnight service (specifying "no signature required"). Examples of invalid entries that will be returned to sender due to being too late:

- ✓ Entrants who put their entry into the mailbox one day before closing date "because it usually takes the post office only a day to deliver it across town", whose entries then take two days to get across town.
- ✓ Entrants who email the Trial Secretary on day of closing asking if it's okay to fax or email their entry to her, with the fee to follow in the mail later.
- ✓ Entrants who get their entries postmarked with the closing date's date; be aware closing date is not "date it must be postmarked by".

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded 1st-4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to Excellent B dogs earning a Double-Q. First place in each jump height class will receive a dog toy valued between \$2 and \$5. Dogs completing a title on either day will receive a mug. Dogs earning the MACH title will receive a special rosette and MACH bar. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial, please contact the Trial Secretary!

Special Awards for High Scoring Terv In Each Class Each Day

An award shall be given to the high scoring terv with a qualifying score in each class, grouping regular together with preferred. Placement determined by score, ties shall go to the dog whose time is the most seconds under the Standard Course Time. 15 awards total available to give out.

- High Scoring Terv in Standard Excellent (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in Standard Open (Regular, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in Standard Novice (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in JWW Excellent (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in JWW Open (Regular, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in JWW Novice (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday and Sunday)
- High Scoring Terv in FAST Excellent (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday only)
- High Scoring Terv in FAST Open (Regular, Preferred) (Saturday only)
- High Scoring Terv in FAST Novice (A, B, Preferred) (Saturday only)

Trial Site and Accommodations

There is **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING** for RV's, sorry.

The trial will be held outdoors on grass. There will be two rings (each 100' x 100'). There is a little shade. This is a public park and anything left overnight is left at your own risk, however there will be a couple club members staying on-site overnight as a small measure of security. Parking is in the parking lot. Lunches will be available on-site; workers can earn a free lunch by working a class.

From 280: take Page Mill Road exit East. Continue on Page Mill Road for 3.7 miles past El Camino, under the RR overpass, through several traffic lights. Turn right onto Middlefield Road (the light after the light at Cowper). Continue south on Middlefield Rd for 1 mile, past the light at East Meadow, to the next light which is a light that controls access to the Middlefield entrance to Mitchell Park. Turn right here into the Mitchell Park parking lot.

From 101, take the San Antonio South exit. Keep straight on San Antonio until the first light. At the first light, turn right onto Charleston Rd (Unocal 76 on the corner). Continue one half mile to the second light. At the second light, turn right onto Middlefield Rd. Continue to the first light which is a light that controls access to the Middlefield entrance to Mitchell Park. Turn left here into the Mitchell Park parking lot.

Notice to Exhibitors

- ❖ This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs who may not compete include bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.
- ❖ Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- ❖ Refunds for bitches in season will be made less applicable AKC and judges fees, provided the Trial Secretary is notified in writing or email before the start of the trial (8AM Saturday, June 12th, 2010). Notifications received after the start of the trial will not receive a refund.
- ❖ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- ❖ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ❖ EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- ❖ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- ❖ All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The trial site is a public park where the city leash laws are in effect and enforceable.
- ❖ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- ❖ Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- ❖ Exhibitors, while competing, must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open-toed shoes.
- ❖ The presence of dogs under six months of age is prohibited at AKC agility trials.
- ❖ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. A current rabies vaccination is required in the State of California.

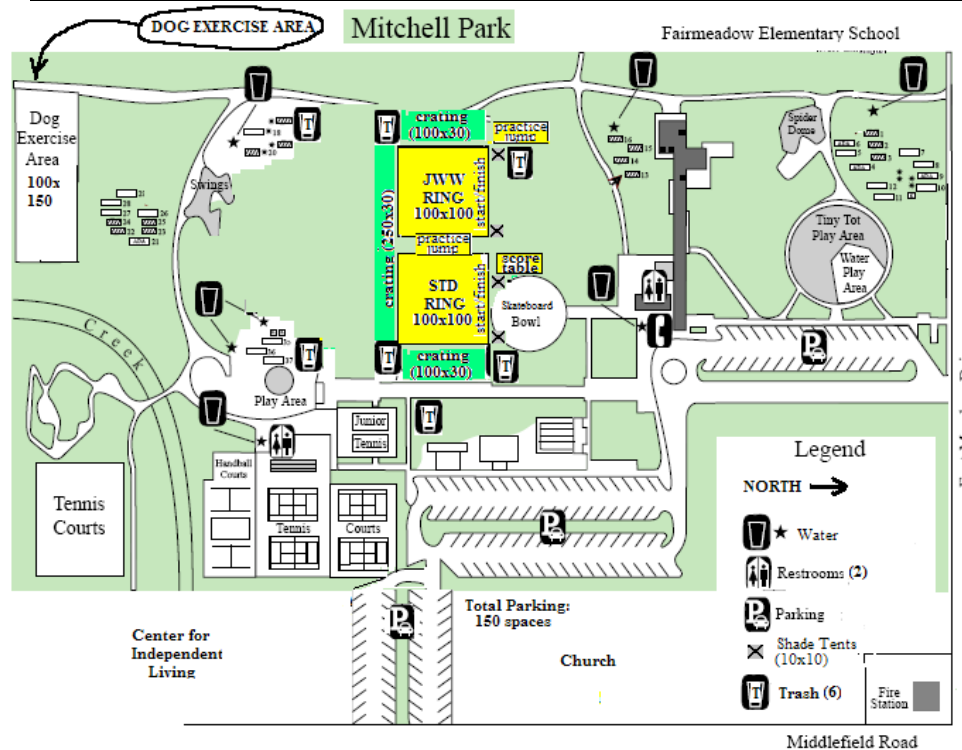

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
