In order to run efficiently and get you finished up in time to enjoy the rest of the activities at the fairgrounds, we'd be in your debt if you did the following:

- ✓ Check in *early* and inform the gate stewards as soon as you can about possible conflicts. ONLY the gate steward may make changes in the running order!
- ✓ Volunteer to help, if you see the need.
- ✓ Stay within shouting distance of your gate steward when you are within 5 dogs of running.

CONFLICTS

We will do our best to accommodate you if you have to be in two places at once, but we must be informed of the conflict if we are going to be able to do anything.

SHOW ETIQUETTE

We want to be invited back again to this campus, so be fanatic about cleaning up after your dog, and not waking up the neighbors first thing in the morning!

Please remember that dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash at all times while in the general area of the trial grounds including the potty areas and while walking to and from search areas. (Flexi leashes are not permitted except during searches). To ensure the safety of all dogs, please keep a minimum of 8 feet between dogs unless expressed consent is given. If your dog is dog-reactive and you wish to use a red bandana to let others know your dog needs extra space, please plan to provide your own bandana for your dog. If a competitor chooses to have their dog "sit" with them outside the vehicle the dog must be crated (i.e. a competitor sitting in a chair with their dog on leash outside of a crate is not allowed). X-pens must be covered with a secure top.

DIRECTIONS TO Alameda County Fairgrounds, Pleasanton

4501 Pleasanton Ave, Pleasanton CA 94566.

From Highway 680: Take the Bernal Ave exit and go East on Bernal—away from the hills. Turn left onto Valley Ave., which is the second traffic light. Enter through gate 12. Drive past the guard station. At stop sign, slight right to Race Barns. Parking will be the grass/weed lot on your left.

SITE INFO

Setup: No exhibitor set ups before Wednesday 3pm. Come prepared with your own shade and water. Remember dogs may not be loose in vehicles with open windows or tied to a vehicle or other stationary object.

Parking Permits: The fairgrounds will charge a daily parking fee. The Fairgrounds is offering a multi-day parking pass which does include in/out privileges. Exhibitors need to ask for the multiday pass when entering the fairgrounds the first day. Show Committee members only may park in the Race Barn area. All others may come in to unload but then must move to the weed parking lot. .

Overnight Parking for RVs: RV parking will be in the fairgrounds official campground. Reserve your space through the fairgrounds at http://www.alamedacountyfair.com/rv_camping.html.

Unloading. Be prepared to cart your stuff in from where you park in the parking lot. You will not be able to drive on the field and you may not park at the red curb for unloading.

Security. There will no professional overnight security however there will be club members on site overnight Friday night and Saturday night keeping a watchful eye on our equipment. You may leave your canopies and crating but we do not recommend leaving anything valuable.

FOOD

There will be several food vendors onsite selling breakfast and lunch items and beverages. The vendors will be located at a walking distance of approximately a 5—7 minutes from the agility rings. Lunch will be provided for the all volunteers. Drinking water will be provided at the hospitality table in Igloo containers. Bring your own drinking vessel. No cups will be provided.
