ENTRIES CLOSE Friday, April 2, 2021 at 11:00 PM (PDT) at the address of the Trial Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or changed, except for as provided in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.

WAIT-LIST - RBTF is offering a wait-list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on April 2, 2021, 11:00 pm, except for bitches in season. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait-list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Entries will be refunded if the show is canceled due to COVID 19.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor or shredded. Please make sure we can read your entry! Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Bitches in season: Full refund, less a 10 processing fee will be given for bitches in season after the closing date. A written request is required to receive a refund and the request must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 24 hours prior to the start of judging. If there is an available wait-listed participant, a full refund will be given.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section). Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants. AKC Rules, Regulations, Policies and Guidelines are available on the American Kennel Club website: www.akc.org

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

MAIL ONLY- To be acceptable, submit entry, with the required entry fee, on an official AKC entry form, or copy, including the agreement and instructions. Please type or neatly print.

-The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.

-Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax or email entries will not be accepted.

-The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.

-Entries will receive an email confirmation within 7 days after receipt, if an email address is provided on the entry form, otherwise, the confirmation will be sent via USPS standard mail. If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.

-Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging.

-Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

-The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.

-The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.

-Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.

-There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.

-In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.

-Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

-MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to judging.

-BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee, less a \$10 processing fee, unless the spot can be filled by someone on the wait-list.

Rules for entering this trial:

DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK!!! (If the club is able to fill your entries from the wait-list, your entry fees will be refunded.)

DO NOT COME if you have traveled out of the state and have not sheltered in place for 14 days!

DO NOT COME if you have been to any large gatherings within the 14 days prior to this trial!

Grounds rules:

1. NO overnight & NO day of RV parking.
2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
3. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.
4. There will be a door monitor, you will only be allowed to enter the building under the supervision of the door monitor.
5. When entering the building you will enter and exit through the front door.
6. Once you exit the ring you will need to exit the building.
7. You may not be allowed to watch from inside the building.
8. Check - in will be done outside the building.
9. Crating – there will be NO crating in the building. You will be required to crate from your vehicle. Bring canopies and/or shade cloth. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working. Note: farm animals and cats on property. Air (potty) your dog on gravel driveway. Do not air on grass, plants, barn or equipment. Note: water is well water and safe to drink.
10. **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Covid 19 – best practices:

1. Participants are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event.
2. You will be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in the building. You may not enter the building if you are not wearing a mask, which means you will be required to wear a mask in the ring while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!
3. For parking – leave at least a vehicle or two space between your vehicles. There is plenty of parking.
4. Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
5. Consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others.
6. If you utilize the portable toilet, wash your hands before and after you enter.
7. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
9. Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.
