Entries will be processed on a first received basis. Limit 660 runs per day. No hand delivery of entries within the first 24 hours of opening date and time. Maximum of 10 entries per envelope. Entries may not be accepted or cancelled after the closing date. All fees must be paid in U.S. funds only. Minimum charge of \$25 for all returned checks. Permission has been granted by the American Kennel Club for the holding of this event under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Mr. James P. Crowley, Secretary.

## MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

### Move-ups and other changes

In advance of the trial weekend, dogs may be moved up to a higher level at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing or email by the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on the Monday preceding the event.

**There will be day to day move-ups at the show**, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within **15 minutes after the end of the last class**. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial. **However**, a dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class in which it is not eligible to be entered due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

### Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time

If entry limits should be exceeded either day, RBTF Inc is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date/time. Any entries withdrawn that are received by the **Wednesday preceding the event** will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

## Trial Site and Accommodations

**There is NO OVERNIGHT PARKING for RV's, sorry.**

The trial will be held outdoors on grass. There will be two rings (each a minimum of 100' x 100'). There is little shade. This is a public field and anything left overnight is left at your own risk, however there will be a couple club members staying on-site overnight as a small measure of security. Parking is in the parking lot. Lunches will be available on-site; workers can earn a free lunch by working a class.

### Directions

From 101: exit San Antonio Road South. Turn **RIGHT** onto Middlefield Road. Turn **LEFT** at first traffic light into the parking lot, opposite Montrose.

From 280, exit Page Mill Road East. After approx 2 miles, continue across El Camino and continue under the RR overpass (Page Mill becomes Oregon Expway). Turn **RIGHT** onto Middlefield. Travel approx 2 miles past East Meadow and past Charleston. Turn **RIGHT** at the first traffic light into the parking lot, opposite Montrose.

*Important heads up about getting into the community center: you'll get lost if you don't enter the parking area via the traffic light at Montrose! It's a real traffic light, so it's easy to turn at.*

### Awards

- Rosettes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores.
- Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores.
- Pins will be awarded to Masters (formerly Exc B) dogs earning a QQ or QQQ on a single day (thanks to Lorie Abbott for providing the pins!).
- First place in each jump height class will receive a dog toy valued between \$2 and \$5. Dogs completing a title on either day will receive a mug.
- Dogs earning the MACH title will receive a special rosette and MACH bar. If you anticipate you may complete your MACH at our trial, please contact the Trial Secretary!

## Dogs Eligible To Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (if offered by the club), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

## Notice to Exhibitors

- ❖ Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- ❖ Refunds for bitches in season will be made less applicable AKC and judges fees, provided the Trial Secretary is notified in writing or email before the start of the trial (8AM Saturday). Notifications received after the start of the trial will not receive a refund. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.
- ❖ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee. If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- ❖ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ❖ EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- ❖ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- ❖ All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The trial site is a public park where the city leash laws are in effect and enforceable.
- ❖ Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- ❖ Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- ❖ Exhibitors, while competing, must wear proper footwear. Exhibitors will not be allowed to compete in "bare" feet or open-toed shoes.
- ❖ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. A current rabies vaccination is required in the State of California.

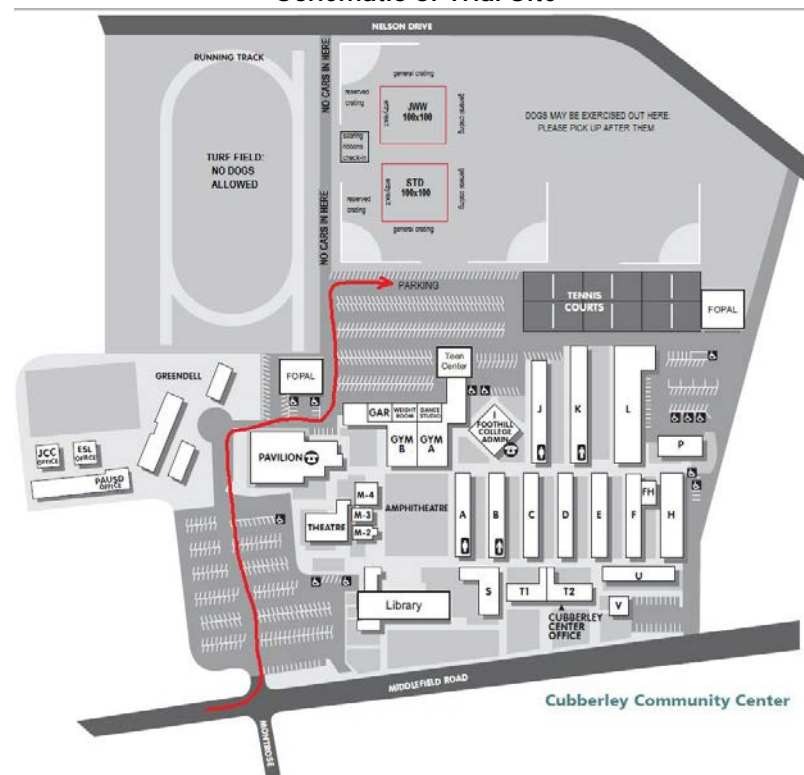

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners <sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? \_\_\_\_\_
